

IV. EUROPEAN EXHIBITION OF RACING PIGEON CZECH REPUBLIC - BRNO 2014
(31.1.2014 - 1.2.2014)

A) The animal health conditions for the pigeon import from the European Union member countries in accordance with Council Directive 92/65/EEC:

1 / Pigeons must come from a holding or an area, which is not subject to restrictions under measures to be applied to combat Newcastle disease;

2 / Pigeons must come from a holding in which avian influenza has not been diagnosed in the 30 days preceding the dispatch;

3 / To be admitted to the exhibition, pigeons must be accompanied by a valid health certificate, which is in compliance with the Articles 1 and 2 of the Directive, and this certificate must be issued by the official veterinarian or by the veterinarian responsible for the holding of origin and empowered for this purpose by the competent authority;

The health certificate must contain the following information:

- Name and address of the breeder, including region and country of origin
- Number of pigeons
- Marking of pigeons
- Place and address of their destination (*European exhibition of racing pigeons, BVV Brno - Výstaviště 1, 647 00 Brno, Czech Republic*)
- Information on pigeons clinical examination min. 48 hours prior to the dispatch, and the confirmation, that pigeons are clinically healthy
- Information that pigeons do not come from a country or its area, which is subject to veterinary restrictions under measures to be applied to combat Newcastle disease and avian influenza and which, according to above mentioned, prohibit the movement of animals
- Information, that pigeons were vaccinated against Paramyxovirus, including the vaccine information, the date of vaccination and the duration of immunity claimed by a vaccine manufacturer
- Date and place of certificate issue

B) The animal health conditions for the pigeon import from third countries

These health conditions will be issued only in case of attendance of countries outside the EU; in that case the conditions will be sent to the participants in due time.
